Notices and Fines

The Olympic Village Board has approved a new rule regarding outdoor fire pits. No fire pits of any kind, e.g. wood, gas, propane, are permitted on Olympic Village grounds. Existing fire pits must be removed no later than February 15.

The Board passed a resolution that residents who remain out of compliance with community rules will be assessed a fine. When a resident is asked to comply with an Olympic Village rule and does not comply within 10 days per Exhibit D Olympic Village Rules of Residency, the resident will be fined \$25.00 per week until the noncompliance is corrected. Upon compliance the resident must contact Janelle Taylor, RCM to inform her the situation has been addressed and to have the fine stopped. If, once inspected, it is determined the issue was not brought into compliance, the fine will be assessed from the original date until such time it is corrected. For episodic or single occurrence infractions (e.g. unleashed dog), fines up to \$25.00 may be assessed per incident.
